Description: Using the SMART Board Notebook 10.6 software, teachers will learn how to manipulate the SMART Board features and tools across their curriculum. Teachers will learn how to use the software and also learn how to use the SMART Board itself. It is recommended that participants bring their own curriculum materials to practice with the SMART Board software. Participants are encouraged to bring a flash drive for easy saving of lessons created using the SMART Board software and for lesson sharing with other participants. The Notebook software and resources can be downloaded for free at www.smarttech.com with a valid user license and/or serial number from their own school.

Session 1: Basic Use of SMART Boards and SMART Notebook

This session will give the participant a general overview of how SMART Boards can be used everyday in classrooms. It will include an overview of how all the components work together and how to use SMART Board in the classroom.

Session 2: Building and Formatting SMART Notebook Pages and Files

This session will focus on building notebook pages using SMART Notebook 10.6 software, format text and objects, and learn how to use the basic features of the software.

Session 3: Using Basic Features in SMART Notebook

This session will show participants how to group, layer, and animate objects within Smart Notebook and use those features on the Board. This session will also use the Gallery to add items to pages to improve lessons.

Session 4: Toolkit and Lesson Sharing

This session will explore the Smart Notebook toolkit and imbed objects from other software and/or sources. There will also be time for participants to share. Bring a flash drive to collect and share files created by others.
