Description:

Classroom libraries are an integral part of your classroom. The titles that are included in these libraries should be reflecting the current trends in children’s literature, authors from the Core Curriculum, and content related in history and math. This 5 hour workshop will provide teachers with an overview of what to include in their libraries by grade level. Participants will be introduced to titles that embrace the curriculum areas and also are appropriate to the student’s independent reading levels. At the end of the second session, the participants will have a bibliography of titles that should be included in their classroom libraries.

Session 1 – Cleaning house – taking a look at what you have on your classroom shelves and how to “weed” out titles to update your library. Instructor will book talk various books in alignment with the ELA core curriculum, history and math standards.

Session 2 – Building your library - Participants will have the opportunity to review many titles appropriate to their grade level and compile an annotated bibliography of titles on a wish list. A bibliography of the participants’ book choices will be emailed to all participants.
